

APPLYING FOR WINTRINGHAM HOUSING GUIDE

Thank you for your interest in Wintringham Housing.

Wintringham is a not-for-profit organisation that is renowned for its quality in care and support for older people. Wintringham Housing is a subsidiary of Wintringham and a registered Housing Association. Together, they work to ensure support is provided alongside affordable housing, in order to promote long term sustainable tenancies.

Wintringham¹ provide accommodation options across Victoria and Tasmania, however this housing guide relates to housing available in Victoria only.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- □ Aged 50 years and over
- Able to live independently in the community (may require some support or assistance)
- Australian citizen, or permanent resident of Australia
- Approved applicants through the Victorian Housing Register (VHR) Priority Access

REGISTERING YOUR INTEREST FOR WINTRINGHAM HOUSING

1) VHR Registration with Priority Access

There are 3 ways to register on the VHR

- Online Application
- Paper Application
- Through a Support Agency

When you apply through the VHR, you can elect to have your application automatically registered with other Housing Associations including Wintringham and Homes Victoria.

If you are homeless or at risk of homelessness, you may be eligible for Priority Access. You might need a Housing Support Worker to fill in a Priority Access application form with you.

2) Completing Wintringham's Assessment Forms

- Part A Referral and Intake
- Part B Housing Information

You can download these forms from our website or contact our Intake and Service Information team.

Our housing is assessed on need and priority. The Referral and Intake Form and Housing Information Form will help us to assess your housing and support needs. If you have a Support Worker from another agency, you might ask them to help you complete the forms.

Our Intake and Service Information team can be contacted if you need further advice.

NB. If you are a Support Worker from an Access Point assisting an applicant, you will only need to submit Part A – Referral and Intake form, if you also attach the IAP referral form.





3) Completing Consent Forms

- Centrelink Authority Income and Asset Consent
- > Consent to Obtain and Exchange Information (if you are self-referring only)

You can download this form from our website or contact our Intake and Service Information team. The consent forms will allow Wintringham to access your income and asset details from Centrelink, in order to determine eligibility, and provide consent to provide and obtain information.

Can Wintringham house families?

Most units are single occupancy. We have a small number of two bedroom units in St Arnaud, Shepparto and Coburg, which are suitable for couples, or established care or share arrangements. For these properties, both applicants must be eligible for Wintringham Housing. Please complete a Referral and Intake form per person. Both applicants need to be 50 years of age.

What is the rental cost?

Rental fees for housing are based on the income of a resident and their associated assets. It will not be any more than 25-30% of your income.

REMEMBER

Do not forget to state your preferred Wintringham housing locations on your application.
