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WILLIAMSTOWN DESCRIPTION OF ROOMS & ACCOMMODATION PAYMENTS

Greetings from Wintringham!

There are a few things you'll want to know about the quality and cost of our accommodation.

ACCOMMODATION PRICING

All residents pay a daily care fee being 85% of the Aged Care pension.

SUPPORTED ROOMS

If the pension is your only income and you have assets under \$61,500, there is nothing more to pay. You will have what is known as a 'Supported Room'. There are 36 Supported Rooms at Williamstown Hostel.

NON SUPPORTED ROOMS

There are also 24 Non-Supported Rooms at Williamstown Hostel. These are for people who have assets over \$61,500. Non-Supported Rooms incur additional accommodation charges regulated by the Australian Government (www.myagedcare.gov.au). The level of the accommodation charge for Non-Supported Rooms is agreed with you based on your individual financial circumstances.

You can choose to pay for the accommodation charge by a refundable deposit, a daily payment, or a combination of both.

A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum. At Williamstown Hostel, the standard Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) is \$550,000. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example fortnightly. At Williamstown Hostel, the standard Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) is \$117.23.

An alternative is to make a partial lump sum payment combined with a daily payment. For instance, at the standard level, a 50% refundable deposit combined with a 50% daily payment would amount to \$275,000 RAD and \$58.62 DAP.

DESCRIPTION OF ROOMS

Wintringham's Williamstown Hostel has 60 rooms, each with a private en-suite. Each room can be occupied by one person.

Rather than just a room, Wintringham Williamstown provides a high quality, fully-renovated and substantial unit. Its size, excluding the en-suite, is a remarkable 21.5 square metres.

In addition to a spacious bedroom area with built in wardrobe and en-suite, the unit includes a kitchenette and space for a small dining suite. The unit's back door provides direct access to the communal amenities. The front door leads to a veranda and garden area. All residents have access to two lounges, dining room and other common areas which have been furnished with homely antique furniture. There is a stylish private dining room where family and friends can be entertained. The hairdressing salon offers professional hairdressing weekly.
